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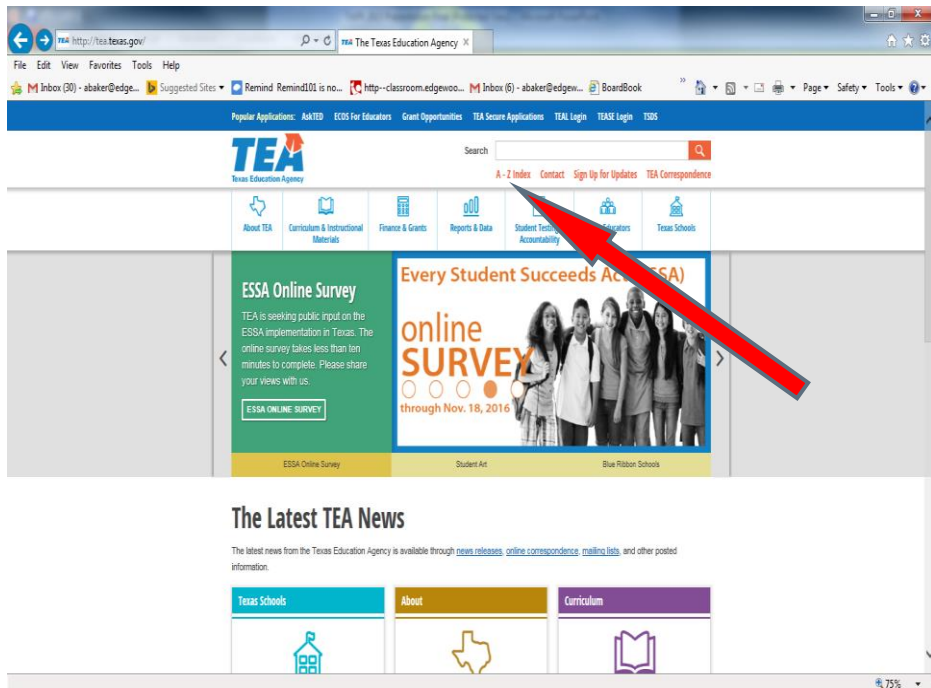
Texas Academic Performance Report - Overview

- The TAPR provides information on the performance of students in each school and district in Texas. The reports also provide extensive information on school and district staff, programs, and student demographics.
- Per state law...School Districts must hold a Public Meeting to discuss TAPR results within 90 calendar days of receiving the information from the Texas Education Agency (TEA).
- Per state law...School Districts must publish their TAPR information on their website within two weeks following the Public Meeting
- Districts and Campuses earn a rating of *either...Met Standard* or *Did Not Meet Standard*

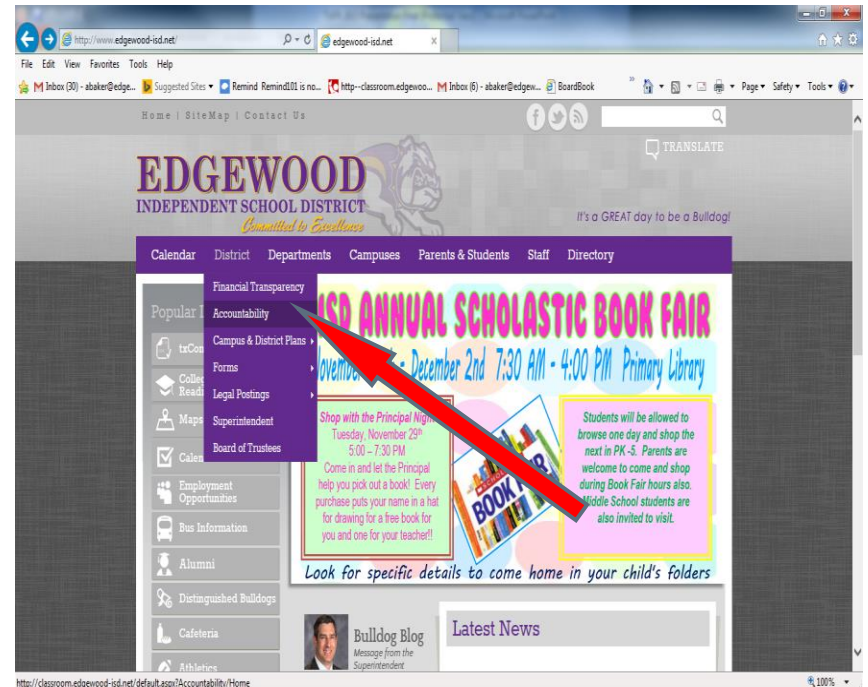

New for 2015-16 Ratings

- Special Education Exams for 3-8 Mathematics (STAAR A & STAAR Alternate) - included in campus and district proficiency ratings for the first time.
- College and Career Ready Graduates – Line added to include the percentage of graduates from the class of 2015 who met the criteria for demonstrating college and career readiness.
- AP/IB Participation and Examinees \geq Criterion by Subject – Lines added to Postsecondary section to list AP/IB performance and examinees greater than criterion by subject for reading/ELA, math, science, and social studies.
- Advanced Course/Dual Enrollment Completion – Lines added to Postsecondary section to list Advanced Course/Dual Enrollment Completion for English Language Arts, Math, Science, and Social Studies.

What do the passing percentages represent?

- **2015 English I EOC example:**
 - **All Freshmen students enrolled in EISD at the October 31st, 2015 “snapshot, and**
 - **Freshmen students still enrolled in EISD who take the English I EOC First Administration in May, 2016, and**
 - **Freshmen students still enrolled in EISD who did not pass the First Administration will take the Second Administration in June, 2016, and**
 - **Sophomore students still enrolled in EISD who did not pass the Second Administration who took the Third Administration (final) in December, 2016**
- **Students taking 5th and 8th Reading & Math and all EOC exams must pass within their first 2 attempts to be reflected as a “passer” for both campus and district accountability**
 - **Students failing to pass EOC on their second attempt must take that exam each time it is offered until successful (up to 10 times)**
- **Students who pass the exam on or after their 3rd attempt full fill their graduation requirement, but will always be recorded as a “non-passer” for both district and campus accountability purposes.**
- **All other grades and subjects...no retest offered...scored from First Administration only**
